New Membership Signup

1. New members will be inducted once per year at the April monthly meeting, or as deemed necessary by the Board until the membership cap is reached. Dues after the April meeting will be prorated for new members.
2. The membership committee recommends prospective members visit the range with another club member prior to enrollment night.
3. Prospective members are encouraged to attend a club meeting to turn in their application and get the Secretary to enter their name on the Waiting List. Prospective member's names should be on the waiting list at the earliest date possible. New members are invited based on their seniority on the waiting list. No names are added based on telephone requests. Meetings are conducted on the first Monday of every month unless it is a holiday. In this case the meeting will be on the second Monday.
4. People on the waiting list should arrive at the appropriate time provided for the April meeting for the enrollment process. **PS-We won't be telephoning you with a reminder.**
5. You must present a photocopy of either your Illinois FOID or a photocopy of your out of state driver license card at this time of induction into NIRPC, (the April meeting). You must also supply a copy of your proof of NRA membership. A photocopy of your NRA membership card or a magazine address label showing your NRA membership number and expiration date is required. If the required information is not provided, your entry into the club will be delayed. Absolutely no exceptions.
6. At the designated time, the membership committee will begin going down the waiting list; filling any openings based on seniority position on the waiting list. Anyone not present will forfeit his or her position. When the membership limit is reached, sign up will end. **NO EXCEPTIONS**-you must be present to join. If you work second shift you will need to arrange time off from your employer.
7. New members will be asked to address the club on why they desire to join.
8. New members must pay the orientation fee and regular membership fees (see Article IV) by check or money order made out to NIRPC and given to the Treasurer at the April meeting, or the meeting at which they are inducted into the club. They must also supply a head and shoulder photograph 1.5"H x 1" W in either color or black and white. These will be used for club badges.
9. The Secretary will make each new member a badge and give it and a range key to the Orientation Officer.
10. New members must attend a pre-orientation instruction at the end of the club meeting.
11. New members must attend the Range Orientation Class on the date assigned. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** If for an unexpected reason you can are unable to attend, please contact the Orientation Officer **prior to the class.** If other arrangements cannot be made your money will be refunded.
12. Upon successful completion of the Orientation Class, New members will be presented their badges and keys.
